The weather has been going back and forth regarding temperatures, snow, and ice as we have come to know and expect living in the community we call home.

The unforeseen, which also persists each year, is when and how much snow and ice will we endure for this year's season? As this changes monthly, weekly, and daily, be aware the village is allotted a limited supply of road salt each winter and we utilize our small team available to clear the streets. Most people understand today's reality and currently limited resources and budgets.

With the increased salt prices, we attempt to stretch the entire season by focusing on the ice forecasts and prioritizing intersections, emergency routes, and main areas to keep everyone safe. We work extra hours when necessary to keep roads open.

The snow, although inconvenient at times, when at a lower accumulation, may not be able to salt after every snowfall. In saving resources side streets may take a little longer to clear and some icy patches may need to be addressed as temperature rises for effectiveness.

Everyone can work together and make it through another successful season. Please drive a little slower and allow some extra time during the winter weather. If possible, help neighbors in clearing walking paths. Don't hesitate to report dangerous spots so they can be addressed sooner than later.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we will continue to work on keeping our roads as safe as we possibly can with our resources and your well-being in mind.
